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GENERAL INFORMATION

The Queensland Region of the Australian Limousin Breeders Society invites all young beef enthusiasts to participate in the 2017 Queensland Limousin Youth Camp and Junior Heifer & Led Steer Show.

This event has been successful in creating and maintaining youth interest in Agriculture and related Rural Industries with a specific focus on the Beef Cattle Industry. Recent programs have included opportunities for mature age participants who are new to the industry or who are parents of youth interested in the Limousin breed. It provides excellent opportunities for personal development and increasing self-confidence through parading competitions, judging competitions and public speaking along with a number of novelty events designed to keep the fun in the passion for the industry.

Due to the popularity of this event this year's numbers will be capped to ensure quality time and instruction can be devoted to participants by experienced and enthusiastic instructors.

The entry fee for the participants includes the full cost of the educational hands-on and fun program, all meals from Friday smoko (morning tea) to Sunday lunch, camp shirt and for participants Under 25yrs free 12 months Junior Registration with the Australian Limousin Breeders' Society Ltd. There is no need to have your own steer or registered Limousin heifer for the event as loan animals will be available. Entry forms must be received by closing date to allow the committee to allocate loan animals to competitors. Please note that if there are animal shortages it may be necessary for an animal to be shared by participants.

There will be designated sleeping areas in the show hall, which requires adult supervision for the participants choosing to stay on the show grounds. Please note that the Queensland Limousin Breeders Group & the Australian Limousin Breeders' Society take no responsibility for the participants outside the program hours. The committee encourages all parents/carers to stay and get involved in the show. The success of this event relies on help and participation of parents/carers.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Participants are to be under 25 years of age as of 1st September 2017. If the participant is under the age of 18, a parent/carer must give consent of entry by signing the entry form. **Mature age participants i.e. those over 25 are also welcome and will be catered for in the program.** Whilst all reasonable precautions will be taken by the Committee and the Australian Limousin Breeders' Society to ensure the safety of all attendees, each Competitor or parent/carer signing this form agrees to indemnify the Committee, the Queensland Region of the Australian Limousin Breeders' Society and the Australian Limousin Breeders Society against any claim resulting from any accident or sickness that may occur at the event or associated with the event.

1. Entries must be paid at the time of entry or entries will not be accepted
2. Appropriate dress must be worn at all times. Sun protective clothing is recommended eg collared shirts. No thongs or joggers or other similar footwear allowed while working with cattle or around cattle sheds.
3. **Camp numbered bibs must be worn at all times for identification purposes**
4. ALCOHOL & SMOKING- No alcohol to be consumed or smoking permitted by persons under 18. There is no smoking permitted in the cattle sheds, toilets, eating areas or sleeping areas.
5. **All participants enter at their own risk. Insurance and public liability is the responsibility of the competitor.**
6. Exhibitors/participants must supply their own equipment and feed unless they are using a loan animal in which case the owners will provide equipment and feed.
7. Bedding for stalls will be supplied
8. No dogs will be allowed on the grounds
9. Any disruptive or unacceptable behaviour from any individual or group of individuals will not be tolerated. Such behaviour may result in disqualification from activities and/or exclusion from the grounds.
10. All exhibits must have an acceptable docility and be broken to lead. Any animal not meeting these requirements may be withdrawn from competition/use
11. All cattle must carry an NLIS device. **PIC # for Murgon Showgrounds is QEMG1000**
12. Nose grips/rings are compulsory for all animals at all times when being led.
13. Cattle are to be attended to by the participant allocated to that animal during the camp.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

14. Participants allocated to 'Young guns' can have assistance as required throughout the camp.
15. Intermediate and advanced competitors are not permitted to receive any assistance on judging day.
16. It is the responsibility of the owners of animals to ensure all travel documents and requirements and health status of all animals conform with the relevant legislation.
17. Ribbons/prizes/ money go to the participant leading the animal.
18. Accommodation/bedding is the responsibility of the participant/parent/carer however there will be designated sleeping areas. A night curfew for participants will be imposed during the camp.
19. All electrical equipment and power cords must have a current 'test and tag' status.
20. Registrations will not be accepted without payment - all fees are non-refundable
21. Shirts will be supplied to all participants, these are to be worn on "Show day". Other items may be supplied by sponsors and may be required to be worn at designated times during the camp. All participants must conform to these requirements.
22. Stud cattle **must be** registered with their respective Society. All entries must comply with their society rules and regulations
 - a. Animals nominated in Limousin Heifer and Limousin Bull Classes must be fully registered with the Australian Breeders Society
 - b. Non Limousin animals and unregistered Limousin cattle are eligible to compete in the all breeds classes
23. Age of cattle will be taken as of the 1st September 2017
24. Heifers must be under 24 months (no calf at foot)
25. Bulls must be under 12 months of age
26. Liability in relation to any cattle remains with the owner.
27. Any decisions/ directions given by the Murgon Youth Camp Committee / Qld Limousin Breeders Group Committee are final and must be adhered to.
28. All cattle returning to **tick free** areas will be required **to spray out on Sunday afternoon** before departing, this service will be available onsite.
29. All cattle attending camp must have a **J-BAS 7 or higher status**

CATERING

Meals for competitors are included in the registration fee. This includes Friday morning tea to Sunday lunch.

Extra meals for parents/carers/others will be catered for and must be ordered on the registration form at a cost of \$66 dollars per person.

Disposable plates and cutlery will be supplied. Soft drinks & water will be available to purchase at the canteen.
